- Electrical troubleshooting of machining operations such as broaching, turning, spline rolling, gauging, washing, milling, drilling, grinding, CD and laser welding.
- Troubleshooting of automated material handling, conveyance devices and robotics.
- Experience with Fanuc robots and CNC controls, Allen-Bradley PLC's and industrial controls, and Siemens controls as it pertains to troubleshooting machines is required. Experience in programming these is a plus.
- Knowledge of current industrial electrical standards and codes (NEC, NFPA 79).
- Ability to read and understand electrical schematics.
- Ability to read and understand hydraulic and pneumatic schematics.
- Ability to read and understand blueprints.
- General machine rebuild skills required.
- Perform predictive and preventative maintenance.

- Knowledge of AC motors and variable frequency drives.
